Diana's Poll Worker Tips

As a poll worker with a disability, I was a role model for PW on how to interact with all voters.



- Get plenty of sleep
- Bring a seat cushion
- Walk around when you can
- Bring some snacks
- Look around to help others
- Respect people
- Talk to the voter, not the care worker
- Ask for help, if you need it
- Listen to people with disabilities

Civic Engagement: Getting your voice heard



- Go to community meetings about voting
- Use social media to share information
- Work with community groups to educate people about voting
